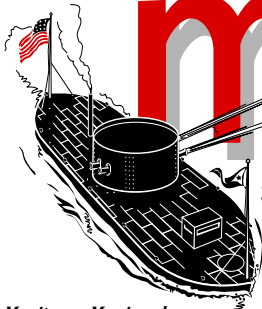
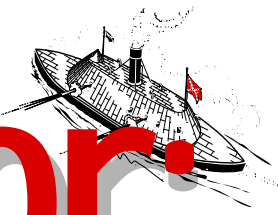

### WELFARE FUND REPORT

Trustee Marty Tew reports for the Welfare fund for October, 2008, that Ordinary Income of \$3,995,164.56 plus Investment Income of (\$2,820,821.14) minus Expenses of \$3,185,301.98 yielded a Net Income of (\$2,010,958.56). For the Fiscal Year to Date, Ordinary Income of \$22,509,669.67 plus Investment Income of (\$5,292,133.97) minus Expenses of \$18,166,606.76 yielded a Net Income of (\$949,071.06). The Fund Value as of 10/31/08 was \$88,864,012.84.

### PENSION FUND REPORT

Trustee Rick Ascher reports for the Pension Fund for October, 2008, that Income of \$4,067,126.31 plus Investment Income (\$48,451,449.04) minus Expenses of \$2,372,957.52 yielded a Total Net Income of (\$46,757,280.25). For the Fiscal Year to Date, Ordinary Income of \$25,667,413.43 plus Investment Income of (\$83,133,619.43) minus Expenses of \$16,971,395.30 yielded a Total Net Income of (\$74,437,601.30). As of 10/31/08, the Fund Value was \$440,170,781.34.

**School**

As of our last JATC Board Meeting, there are presently 176 regular Apprentices at the school, and the unemployment rate is 11%. We have four industrial Apprentices, 17 on Leave of Absence, including five military absences, a 45% minority rate, and two female Apprentices. As of 10/31/08, the Fund market value was \$3,437,822. Efforts are being made to upgrade the respiratory/pulmonary function testing process, a new wage scale system is being set up for Category II Apprentices, and there are new right-to-privacy statement policies and procedures under way.
