inancial Reports for April, 2013, indicated that Ordinary Income of \$179,378.64 plus Investment Income of \$59,518.02 minus Expenses of \$100,263.37 yielded a Net Income of \$138,633.29.

For the Fiscal Year-to-Date, Ordinary Income of \$614,351.05 plus Investment Income of \$108,638.76 minus Expenses of \$588,767.79 yielded a Total Net Income of \$134,222.02. The JATC Fund Value as of 4/30/13 was \$5,329,896.08.

WELFARE FUND REPORT

Financial Reports for the Health & Welfare Fund for April, 2013, indicated that Ordinary Income of \$3,343,779.56 plus Investment Income of \$2,329,284.35 minus Expenses of \$3,337,548.80 yielded a Net Income of \$2,335,515.11.

For the Fiscal Year-to-Date, Ordinary Income of \$39,248,942.03 plus Investment Income of \$9,260,385.02 minus Expenses of \$34,800,026.27 yielded a Net Income of \$13,709,300.78.

The Fund Value as of 4/30/13 was \$115,352,225.24.

PENSION FUND REPORT

Financial Reports for the Pension Fund for April, 2013, indicated that Ordinary Income of \$3,132,656.51 plus Investment Income of \$8.153.082.01minus Expenses of \$3.742.744.59 vielded a Net Income of \$7.542,993.93.

Since the Fiscal Year begins in April, the Year-to-Date figures match April's numbers.

The Fund Value as of 4/30/13 was \$614,969,931.06.

All contractors will need to make sure their employees have received GHS training by the 12/1/13 deadline. FCAC will offer a GHS overview tentatively scheduled for 8/21/13. We will let everyone know once we have the date and time locked in. On that same date we are planning a demonstration of a record-keeping software package offered by CGM Computer Consulting. Randy Bender of St. Louis is currently testing a slimmed-down version of the software and Randy Brown of CGM has agreed to

give a one-hour talk on the capabilities of this software. He will speak to Contractors afterwards on how this package might help keep track of worker training, notify worker/ employer of impending certification expirations, etc. It's not clear whether this software would be used by Contractors or by PDC 14, since the Union administers Apprentice training.
